What is AVID?

Advancement Via Individual Determination is an internationally-recognized support system for students who are in the academic middle and have the desire and determination to attend a four-year college or university. AVID students are typically first-generation college-goers and may come from an underserved population. AVID students are eased into honors and AP-level coursework and provided with the necessary supports to be successful.

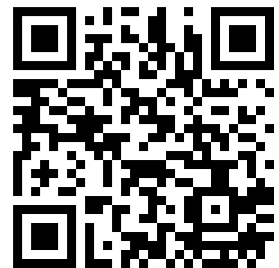
